## Israel - touch, taste and feel TEDxTelAviv pre and post conference experiences

To those of you who are traveling to Israel for the TEDx event in Tel Aviv, what better way to delve into the theme of thriving on turmoil, than by joining us for specially tailored, insider experiences to the North and South of Israel to better understand and get a feel for the history, religions and geo-political situation in this tumultuous part of the world. Our program consists of a two day overnight experience to the North of Israel preceding the TEDxTelAviv event and an additional two day overnight experience in Jerusalem and the Judean desert following the event. Both will be specially designed Ted influenced experiences aimed to touch your senses, stir your imagination and give you a taste of the complication inherent to this region.

### North Experience

Saturday-Sunday **April 24-25**

The overnight to the North includes a breathtaking guided journey through the agricultural heartland of Israel including a stop in Nazareth and the Church of the Annunciation. The journey will continue with visits to the important Christian holy sites around the Sea of Galilee including Kfar Nahum [Capernaum], Tabgha and the Beatitudes Monastery [Mount of Happiness]. An evening dinner at a private home overlooking the Sea of Galilee will be followed by dancing under the stars. Day two of the Northern experience includes a journey through the Golan Heights with a high level security debriefing by a former security forces official in a specially built open air boardroom in one of the most sensitive and strategic locations in the country. A catered lunch of local flavors with a breath taking view of Syria follows.

## Desert-Jerusalem Experience Tuesday-Wednesday **April 27-28**

The desert experience begins with lunch al fresco in the desert overlooking the Dead Sea and the desert canyons, followed by 4\*4 driving through the dramatic landscape of the Judean desert. Some refreshment and bathing in the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth will top off the afternoon.

A night of mystery and desert surprises follows... Bedouin hospitality including coffee, tea and breads served by a traditional Bedouin family in a nomadic tent will precede a mind blowing TED inspired party in the spectacular desert setting.



Day two will commence with a climb to Masada to watch the sunrise from the top of the fortress mountain. After brunch, the journey continues to Jerusalem, beginning with a view of the Mount of Olives and a visit to Gethsemane - the garden where, according to the New Testament and Christian traditions, Jesus watched, prayed, and suffered for the sins of the world the night before he was crucified. The multi-faceted religious nexus that is Jerusalem will then be augmented with a view of Islam's Dome of the Rock and Judaism's Wailing Wall.

Both experiences promise to be unforgettable windows to the natural beauty, rich history, geo-political complexity, cultural diversity and warm hospitality that is Israel.
